



Participant Waiver and Release of Liability Agreement

Please carefully read the following terms and conditions related to your participation in any Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh workshops and events. By registering and participating in any workshops and events you signify your acceptance of and obligation to these terms and conditions. If you have any objections to the following Agreement, you should not register for or attend any workshops or events.

Participant Conduct & Responsibilities:

Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh requires all participants to be respectful and professional to our staff, representatives, volunteers, other attendees and their guests or families throughout the event. Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh reserves the right to ask participants and/or their guests to leave the Facility immediately should they be deemed rude, uncooperative, unprofessional, intoxicated, or in possession of any illegal substance. In such a case, the participant's fees for the event will not be reimbursed under any circumstances.

Waiver and Release: By registering for any event or workshop with Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh participants agree to release Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh, its owners, building owners, representatives, employees, members, and volunteers (hereinafter, "Releasees") from all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action, of whatever kind of nature, either in law or equity, which may hereafter arise from the use of or participation in any event at Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh.

- Release, discharge and promise not to sue Pixie Moss Meadows under its own name or any other name and/or any of its Releasees for any loss, liability, damage, injury, or cost whatsoever arising out of or related to my person or property.
- Indemnify and hold harmless Releasees for any loss, liability, damage, injury or cost that may arise out of or in any way connected with participants use of tools and equipment provided or any acts or omission of Releasees, or other employees.

- **Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh does not provide or handle alcohol.**

Participants understand that **for BYOB listed events ONLY**, if the participant is of legal drinking age (21), they may bring their own unopened container of wine or beer to The Ceilidh studio. Participant will consume alcohol that they bring responsibly, and have been encouraged to take a taxi or carpool if they will be drinking alcohol. **Participants assume all risk for their actions while under the influence of alcohol.** Participant understands that they cannot remove any open container of alcohol from the premises and must leave opened bottles behind for disposal. Participant shall indemnify and hold harmless Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh and its Releasees against all claims and causes of action that may arise based on their conduct at the event, as well as in their coming and going, whether that conduct consists of negligence, recklessness, intentional acts, or otherwise.

Promotions and Copyright: Participant understands that Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh may take photographs and/or video during class and of the class, and that these may be used for marketing, and/or public relations purposes for the studio in various settings including but not limited to: Facebook, Instagram, Pixie Moss Meadows website, flyers, posters, and other promotional materials. Participant understands that if they wish to be exempt from this, they need to speak with a member of Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh staff and make their wishes known in writing in advance of the class. Participant understands that when providing an email address at registration, It may be added to the email list for periodic emails from Pixie Moss Meadows, but the participant will have the option to unsubscribe at the bottom of the emails.

By registering for this event, I forfeit my right to bring a lawsuit against Pixie Moss Meadows/The Ceilidh or its owners, building owners, representatives, employees, instructors, members, and volunteers.
